### ROHS DIRECTIVE (EU) 2015/863

EIZO Technologies GmbH hereby declares that - to the best of its knowledge -, all products manufactured by it conform to Directive (EU) 2015/863 as amended.

Our products contain no more than the weight percent maximum values that are tolerated in homogeneous materials:

- Lead (Pb) (0,1%)
- Mercury (Hg) (0.1%)
- Cadmium (Cd) (0.1%)
- Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) (0,1%)
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) (0,1%)
- Hexavalent Chromium (CR-VI) (0.1%)
- Poly Brominated BiPhenyls (PBB) (0.1%)
- Poly Brominated DiPhenylethers (PBDE) (0.1%)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0,1%)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0,1%)

With the publication of the amended RoHS Directive 2011/65 / EU on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment dated 8 June 2011, the revision was completed at EU level. On July 22, 2019, the third revision of EU Directive 2015/863, RoHS 3 for short, entered into force. The substances listed in the guideline apply to the listed reporting dates.

Dealing with future substance restrictions:

The monitoring of new substances, cited by the European Union, is an integral part of our process to ensure compliance with the above-mentioned directives. EIZO Technologies GmbH will apply these terms and, if necessary, update the compliance statement.
